

I first heard of *The Chaos Machine: The Inside* Story of How Social Media has Rewired Our Minds and Our World on an interview with Max Fisher on THE RICH ROLL PODCAST episode #703. Initially, I assumed the interview was so chock full of information that perhaps I didn't need to read the book. What I learned from the interview stayed with me and was part of so many conversations over the next few days that I decided to listen to the book. I got a lot of cleaning and organizing tasks done because the book was so gripping. Fisher brings a whole new perspective of social media platforms and their impact. In recent years, we have learned a lot from former employees of social media companies in books, on podcasts and in documentary films, such as *The* Social Dilemma. There is ample information available about the hidden and not-so-hidden ways social media algorithms manipulate us. Max Fisher is an investigative journalist for the NYT who explores the impact of social media with some of the most compelling examples and evidence that will motivate you to reconsider how you engage in social media.




